

Preparation for the IB Program:

Students in 9th & 10th grade will follow a recommended course of study in preparation for enrollment in IB courses in their 11th & 12th grade. At least 50% of courses in 9th & 10th grades will be honors level classes including English, Science and History. Students in 9th – 12th grade will maintain a "B" average in all classes. Students will be counseled individually at the end of each grading period if grades, attendance and/or discipline become a concern.
